Key Stage One Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Test

As you may be aware, the above test was inadvertently made available on the internet via the government's own website. Due to this oversight schools will not be administering this test this year. Children's ability in this area will still be assessed and reported to parents in line with guidance. The planned reading and writing test will still be administered during May 2016 and used to inform teacher assessment alongside work that the children have completed in class and teacher's own professional judgement and knowledge of each child's ability. Writing will be assessed by teachers as usual. At Capenhurst we regularly assess every child's writing and moderate our assessments involving each teacher, as well as using external moderators to secure these judgements.
