Hot weather guidance

We have recently enjoyed a week of hot, sunny weather and hopefully everyone enjoyed it safely. At school we will continue to monitor the weather and take appropriate actions to make the children remain safe at school. The local authority have issued a letter from Public Health England directing schools to take note of, and share with their community, the heat wave plan for England. This is a common sense plan to ensure that everyone can enjoy the hot weather whilst remaining safe and well. To help with the plan at school we ask that each child brings a <u>water bottle and sun hat to school everyday</u> as well as applying sun cream before coming to school. Staff will supervise your child applying their own sun cream but can't apply it. Your cooperation in this matter during the remainder of the term will ensure that all children can enjoy the sunshine safely.
