Curriculum news

During the INSET day at the end of last term, the staff met to agree curriculum priorities for the summer term. They have agreed their intentions for the curriculum in each class and these are contained in the curriculum overview which is available on the school website (www.capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk/page/curriculum-20202021/89171).

In-class interventions and additional tuition has been arranged for those pupils who have been identified by staff as needing it. All this will take place during the school day. Options for tuition outside the school day were explored but we felt that space didn't allow for this easily and that the needs of the children would be best met by staff who knew them as much as possible. We have sourced tuition from a trusted and respected retired head teacher who has met with the staff to discuss the needs of the children and they will meet the children this week. We see tuition as an extension of the quality education that each child receives from their class teachers and it is expected that children will move out of this provision as and when gaps are closed.

Homework will also be set each week and children are expected to complete their homework and turn it in. Some children complete very little, if any homework, which is frustrating when time has been spent setting it and other families have spent time completing it.

Testing for Covid-19 - please read carefully and thoroughly

It is important that if your child becomes unwell with any of the COVID-19 symptoms listed below that you get tested. Testing sites are available across Cheshire and Merseyside, with appointments for tests released daily throughout the day and a new centre has opened locally in Ellesmere Port.

At this time it is crucial that **only** people who have **COVID-19 symptoms** book a test. These include:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

There is no need for members of a pupil's household to have a test, unless they are also symptomatic but **ALL** members of the household do need to isolate until the test results are back.

If your child tests positive they should self-isolate and stay off school for 10 days, the rest of the household need to isolate for at least 10 days. If the test comes back negative they can return to school if they no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 48hrs.
