RE Quality Mark

On Monday last week, an assessor visited school to review the quality of the RE provision. She walked around school, spoke with pupils, looked at books and met with Mrs Wilbraham (RE subject leader) and Mrs Arkell (RE teacher). She was very impressed with what she saw and the knowledge the children shared with her, as well as the outcome of her meeting with the staff. As a result school were awarded the REQM at Gold level - this is the highest level of the award. We are understandably very pleased with this and feel that it is an accurate reflection of the standard of RE teaching and level of understanding that the children have within school. Thank you to Mrs Wilbraham and Mrs Arkell for all their hard work through the year and in preparing for the assessment visit.
