We will be asking for contributions of cakes and biscuits to be sent in to be enjoyed by those who come along as well as volunteers to help with the making and serving of coffee as well as setting up and clearing away. The children will be involved in decorating the hall as well as meeting people on arrival and sharing some of their songs from school at various points during the morning. I hope that many of you and your families are able to pop along and support this cause that offers support to so many people.

#### Premier Sports

Mr Hartley will be returning to Capenhurst to continue his sport teaching with all the classes. We are able to continue with this high quality P.E. provision through careful deployment of the Sports Premium funding which is delegated to each school to enhance P.E. provision for all children. We also spend this money on subsiding after-school clubs and other sporting activities as well as paying for swimming teaching and lifeguard provision for school swimming lessons. #### School lunches

The children took part in an online survey in school prior to the end of the summer term and a new three weekly rolling menu was selected from their preferred options. The menus are attached and will also be on the school website, www.capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk and on the noticeboard on the side of school.

School lunches cost £2.20 for children in Y3 and above. Children in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 are still able to receive a free school meal from 1st September 2016.

#### Mid-day vacancies

We continue to have two vacancies for a full-time mid-day assistant. Either role could be split into to a part-week role for anyone who may be interested. If you feel that this is something that you or a family member or friend would be interested in, please contact me at school for further information. The role is an interesting and varied role that involves serving meals, supervising the children as they eat and encouraging them to eat their food, clearing away and cleaning the rooms ready for afternoon school and supervising the children as they play. It is an opportunity to be part of the school team and work closely with all staff to the benefit of the children. We take safeguarding very seriously at Capenhurst and all the required disclosure and barring checks will be made as well as an expectation of confidentiality and professionalism if appointed.
