Swimming Lessons for Classes 3 & 4

Swimming lessons start this Wednesday 14th September for children in KS2 for the duration of the Autumn Term. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time as we will be leaving promptly at 9am in order to arrive in Chester on time. Your child will need to bring appropriate swim wear (one piece swimsuit), goggles if your child usually wears them, and a towel each Wednesday morning. If needed, they should bring a snack from home, as they will miss morning school break so there will be no toast available. It would be useful if they could come to school with their swim wear underneath their school uniform. Please ensure that consents are returned and payment for the coach transport is made by 14th September. Text reminders were sent out last week. Thank you.

In line with this, long hair is to be tied back for school with appropriate and modest hair accessories, preferably red in colour.
