Cheques should be made payable to Scholastic Ltd'. **Community Governance Review** Cheshire West & Chester Council is carrying out two separate Community Governance Reviews in the unparished areas of Chester and Ellesmere Port, with the aim of finding out what governance arrangements exist to enable residents to have their say. Some communities in Cheshire West & Chester are represented locally by town or parish councils while others, known as unparished areas, are represented by different forms of community governance arrangements such as community meetings, neighbourhood management, tenants'/residents' or community associations. Since 2011 the Council has reviewed areas that were already represented by town and parish councils and, as a result, some changes to parish boundaries and parish council arrangements have been made. The Council is now reviewing the unparished areas of Chester and Ellesmere Port - in Ellesmere Port this includes the wards of Ellesmere Port Town, Grange, Ledsham and Manor, Little Neston and Burton (part), Netherpool, Rossmore, St Paul's, Strawberry, Sutton, Whitby and Willaston and Thornton. Stage 1 consultation runs from 20 October to 14 December 2016 and you are encouraged to take part in the Ellesmere Port review at: www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/CommunityGovernanceEllesmerePort
