Christmas Fundraising

Thank you for your support of our fundraising efforts during December. At the two nativity performances, the raffle, baubles and reindeer food raised £191.75. At the Christmas Fayre we raised a total of £257.85 through the raffle, tombolas, baubles, reindeer food and refreshments. Thanks to Friends of Capenhurst for their help at these events.

We also raised a total of £138.05 for our Christmas charity, the Little Faces School, from the collections at the nativities, the sale of Christmas cards and the staff collection in lieu of giving Christmas cards. The collection at the KS2 carol service raised £52.13 for Church.

The sale of the Bags for Life which was sponsored by Capenhurst Nuclear Services and which the children helped to design has so far raised £336 for the school fund. Bags are still available from the school office at £4 each if anyone would like any for friends or family.

<u>PE kits</u>

Thank you to those parents who support the wearing of a PE kit for school PE lessons. A reminder that our PE kit consists of: White round necked T-shirt

Black shorts

Black/navy track suit bottoms (advisable in cold weather)

Trainers (for outdoor P.E.) Pumps (for indoor P.E.)

Spare socks/Sports socks (in case others get wet)

Kit should be brought in to school on Monday and kept on your child's peg until Friday. This term most PE lessons for Classes 1 and 2 will take place in the village hall and so the children will need black PE pumps rather than trainers for PE. As some PE lessons for Classes 3 and 4 will take place outside, each child will need warm PE clothing such as joggers and a sweatshirt - preferably plain and in black or blue rather than an array of different colours. They will also need trainers rather than PE pumps. It is advisable that children in Classes 1 and 2 also have warm PE clothing in plain, dark colours as well as trainers in their PE kits should they need to go outside for PE at anytime. Your cooperation and support with the supply and wearing of suitable PE clothing is much appreciated. Football kits are **not** appropriate for PE lessons and should **not** be worn.

Dinner & Snack Money

Due to staff illness at the end of last term, outstanding dinner/snack money reminders were not sent home before the Christmas holidays. Please look out for them this Friday as some children have quite considerable amounts outstanding.

Going forward, it would be helpful if you could pay for your child's dinners and snacks in advance, at the start of the week/month/term. Many of our families already do this and for that we are grateful. It reduces time spent chasing payments and aids the smooth running of the office.

A school dinner costs £2.20/day (£11/week) for children in KS2. A piece of toast/half a bagel is 30p and a bacon butty (Fridays only) is 60p.

Money/cheques should be sent into school with your child in a named envelope labelled 'School dinners/ snacks'. The children pass any payments through to the office in a plastic wallet during registration. If paying by cheque, cheques should be made payable to 'CWAC'.
