#### Faith Week - 23rd to 27th January

As part of our topic 'One World, Many Faiths' we are holding a Faith Week during the dates shown. During this week the children will be taking part in a variety of activities finding out about and experiencing the faiths and cultures of others. A member of the congregation from Two Mills Presbyterian church will be visiting school to explain the differences between their way of worship and the Anglican traditions and routines that we follow at school. Reverend Gill Foster will be leading our worship in church on Thursday. The children will also be taking part in a Living Islam workshop.

On Friday 27th January each class will take part in a dance workshop where they will learn a dance from a different faith. culture or celebration. There will be an opportunity for you to come along and watch a sharing of these dances and other aspects of our Faith Week during sharing assembly at the end of the day. As this will be a busy sharing assembly it will start at 2.30pm and I ask that children do not bring along extra items for the assembly on this occasion. Stars of the Week and the cups will be awarded as usual.

# Dinner & Snack Money


It would be helpful if you could pay for your child's dinners and snacks in advance, at the start of the week/month/term. Many of our families already do this and for that we are grateful. It reduces time spent chasing payments and aids the smooth running of the office.

A school dinner costs £2.20/day (£11/week) for children in KS2. A piece of toast/half a bagel is 30p and a bacon butty (Fridays only) is 60p.

Money/cheques should be sent into school with your child in a named envelope labelled 'School dinners/ snacks'. The children pass any payments through to the office in a plastic wallet during registration. If paying by cheque, cheques should be made payable to 'CWAC'. Thank you for your support.
