A school dinner costs £2.20/day (£11/week) for children in KS2. A piece of toast/half a bagel is 30p and a bacon butty (Fridays only) is 60p.

Money/cheques should be sent into school with your child in a named envelope labelled 'School dinners/ snacks'. The children pass any payments through to the office in a plastic wallet during registration. If paying by cheque, cheques should be made payable to 'CWAC'. Thank you for your support.

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Funding

We have noticed that, since the introduction of universal free school meals for all of our younger children, the number of families claiming free school meals has fallen significantly. We wanted to remind parents that there are other benefits as well as the meal itself and even if your child is currently having a universal free school meal (R to Y2) or a packed lunch from home, we would like to encourage you to contact the Cheshire West Benefits Team on 0300 123 7039. If you need further help, please ask at the office - we can arrange a quiet space for you to make the phone call from here. An entitlement attracts additional funds for the school from the Government that could benefit your family in many ways: free after school clubs each term; additional curriculum support if your child is struggling with anything at school; help with essential school equipment; an optional meeting with a member of staff to plan how the additional funding can best be used to support your child. If you are not sure whether you may qualify or not, you cannot lose anything by enquiring on the number above, or dropping into the office for some advice.
