On Friday, we will be joining (virtually) staff and pupils from St Oswald's, Bishop Wilson and Christ Church in a shared values day based on the Fruits of the Spirit. We will start the day with shared worship and then each class will focus on a Fruit of The Spirit, enjoying different activities linked to a story from the Bible that exemplifies their focus for the day. Class 1 will focus their work on self-control; class 2 on faithfulness; class 3 on goodness and class 4 on love and kindness. At the end of the day the schools will come back together to share and celebrate their work.

We intend to hold a shared values day each year. It will be an opportunity to explore a person's own faith, find out about how others express their faith and begin to understand how everyone approaches faith in different ways. It is an inclusive day where people of faith, people who are curious about finding a faith and people of no faith can come together to learn and find out more about themselves and each other.



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Class 4 Farm Visit - Tuesday 24th January

Your child will need to arrive at school on time with their swim wear underneath their school uniform as we will be leaving school at 9.00am promptly in order to arrive at EPSV on time. Please ensure your child brings underwear and a towel each Tuesday morning, and a snack from home if needed, as they may miss morning school break.

Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - All in, bring a tin!

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. This token can then be exchanged for a food item from the 'Selfless Shelves' which can then be placed in the Foodbank. Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the shelves - the children see this as a 'Circle of Kindness'. The Foodbank will then use these items to support local families struggling to provide food for themselves.



We will continue to support the West Cheshire Foodbank in our traditional way and food items can be brought in and placed on the 'Selfless Shelves' or directly into the collection box. This week, the Foodbank is particularly in need of tinned potatoes/instant mash, jams and spreads, custard, UHT juice, tinned meat, any non-cook foods eg. pastes, crackers.
