In worship this week ...

...we will be reflecting on how important it is to treat everyone, particularly our elders, with respect. The story being shared demonstrates how easy it can be to look at an older person, one who may be frail or forgetful, someone it may be difficult to visit because you're not sure what to say and assume that their current appearance is the way they have always been. We have been encouraging the children to look beyond that first impression and develop a compassionate curiosity to find out more and respect the life that an older person may have lived. We have asked them to remember the example that Jesus showed through the giving of respect and value to the lives of all people within society.

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the shelves - the children see this as a 'Circle of Kindness'. The Foodbank will then use these items to support local families struggling to provide food for themselves.
