There will be a change to the normal school dinner menu on Thursday 2nd March. The children voted for their favourite meal out of a choice of lasagne, cottage pie and toad-in-the-hole. Keeping Healthy

At Capenhurst we encourage all children to be as healthy as they can be through the encouragement of healthy eating and involvement in physical activity. Taking part in physical activity everyday benefits the mind as well as the body. With this in mind we have introduced an additional opportunity to be active for all children with a 10/15 minute walk on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday (Mondays and Fridays are PE days). This walk will take place on the playground and follow the Golden Mile circuit. It is intended to be a stroll and not a race with staff and pupils walking and talking together providing valuable time away from the formal learning within the classroom alongside physical activity. Those children who complete all three additional sessions will record 2 miles on their Golden Mile tally.
