

In worship this week...

...we are thinking about the symbolism of the cross as we prepare to learn about the Easter story. A cross is a special symbol for Christians - it reminds them of Jesus' death on the cross and his resurrection on Easter Sunday. A cross symbolises different things in different contexts - treasure on a treasure map, love as you sign a card or letter or (in school days of old) that a mistake has been made and needs correcting. Christians use the cross to remind them that they are treasured and special in the eyes of God, God loves them and that Jesus died to take away their sins (mistakes). Christians see the cross as a symbol of hope. May you find peace, hope and love over the Easter break with your family and friends.


