

Supreme Court Ruling - Term Time Holidays

You will no doubt be aware of the recent news coverage concerning term time holidays. In light of the judgment by the Supreme Court, Cheshire West & Chester Council has resumed their policy on term time holidays. The Court acknowledges that there are sound policy reasons for not allowing term time holidays and that ultimately the legal position remains as it was. Unless there are exceptional circumstances, a term time holiday is contrary to s.444(1) of the Education Act 1996 and a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) can be issued accordingly. The summary, which can be found here https://www.supremecourt.uk/cases/docs/uksc-2016-0155-press-summary.pdf gives a good overview of what the arguments were and the view the Court has taken.

Cheshire West & Chester Council will now be resuming the issuing of FPN's for any unauthorised absence taken from the **beginning of this new summer term**. Please be mindful of this when requesting or booking holidays during term time.
