<u>Class 2 Farm Visit - Thursday 4th May</u> A reminder that Class 2 children should wear their PE kit on Thursday 4th May for their visit to the farm. We think that Capenhurst is a welcom- ing community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion.
