T-shirts are to be plain white, without patterns or logos and leggings/joggers/shorts should be plain, logo-free and dark in colour.	<u>Snack Price Increase—Monday 17th April</u> Due to increased food costs, with effect from Monday 17th April, our Friday bacon butty will now cost <b>85p</b> . The cost of a slice of toast will be <b>35p</b> and half a bagel will also be <b>35p</b> . <u>School Dinner Price Increase—Monday 5th June</u> Edsential have also advised that the cost of a school meal will be increasing in the near future. From Monday 5th June, a school meal will cost <b>£2.75</b> for children in Years 3—6. Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - All in, bring a tin! We think that Capenhurst is a welcom- ing community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school.
