Celebrations!

Each week, on Friday afternoons, we award 'Star of the Week' to pupils across school for significant effort and achievement. We also award an Infant Cup and Junior Cup to two pupils whom the staff belief have gone that extra mile with their work or attitude in school. Classes will be given the opportunity to share something of their classwork on a regular basis at each assembly.

Children are invited to bring certificates and news from home that they would like to share related to their hobbies and interests. The assemblies are held in the Village Hall and start at 2.40pm and you are warmly invited to attend.



Progress Score

As you know we are proud of the teaching and learning that all pupils at Capenhurst receive during their time with us and celebrate all achievements made by all children in all year groups. Nationally, schools are allocated progress scores that reflect the progress pupils make through key stage two in reading, writing and maths. These scores are calculated by comparing the attainment at the end of key stage one with that at the end of key stage two for each pupil in Year Six and then comparing it with the progress made by similar groups of pupils at similar schools across the country. I am extremely pleased to report that at the end of 2016/17, our progress scores were 3.9 for writing and 4.6 for maths which puts our school in the top 5% of schools nationally for these subjects and 3.3 for reading which puts our school in the top 25% nationally. This is outside validation of the hard work and dedication shown by pupils, parents and staff in ensuring that all pupils reached their potential and made consistent and excellent progress during their time at Capenhurst.

Premier Sports

Due to a traffic accident, Mr Hartley's return to school will be delayed as he recovers from his injuries - everyone wishes him a full and swift recovery. In the interim, his teaching will be covered by another coach from Premier Sports. We are able to continue with this high quality P.E. provision through careful deployment of the Sports Premium funding which is delegated to each school to enhance P.E. provision for all children. We also spend this money on subsiding after-school clubs and other sporting activities as well as paying for swimming teaching and lifeguard provision for school swimming lessons. School lunches

We have a new three weekly rolling menu for school lunches this year. The menus are attached and will also be on the school website, www.capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk and on the noticeboard on the side of school.

From September 2017, the price of a school lunch has increased to £2.25 for children in Year 3 and above (who are not eligible for a free school meal). Children in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 are still able to receive a free school meal. Prices for snacks remain the same, (30p for toast/half a bagel; 60p for a bacon butty - Fridays only). Please send payment in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name. Cheques should be made payable to "CWAC". Thanks.

Swimming Lessons for Classes

Swimming lessons start on Wednesday 13th September for children in KS2 for the duration of the Autumn Term. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time as we will be leaving promptly at 9am in order to arrive in Chester on time. Your child will need to bring appropriate swim wear (one piece swimsuit), goggles if your child usually wears them, and a towel each Wednesday morning. If needed, they should bring a snack from home, as they will miss morning school break so there will be no toast available. It would be useful if they could come to school with their swim wear underneath their school uniform. Please ensure that consents are returned and payment for the coach transport is made by 13th September. Thank you.
