School Dinners

The children have now tasted the full three weeks of new menus. As a result we have changed a few meals to cater for their preferences. Savoury mince has been replaced with cottage pie and the sausage casserole has been replaced with sausage and mash. We think these small changes will appeal to more children, but will continue to assess the situation as the weeks progress.

Free Cycle Training

The Road Safety Team at CWAC have once again secured funding for cycle training for children during October half term (30th October - 3rd November). The training place will take place at Chester County Officers Cricket Club, Mannings Lane, Upton, Chester CH2 4EU. Courses are available for children between the ages of 3 and 11. Children will need a road worthy bike and helmet to take part. The courses are very popular and places are limited so please book early to avoid disappointment. The Council is charged for children who book a place and do not turn up, so please only book a place if your child is able to attend; a £5 booking fee will be charged. Applying for school places

Parents with children in Year 6 and pre-school children due to start school in September 2018 are reminded that you are now able to apply for Year 7 and reception places online via the Council's website at www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/ admissions

The deadline for high school applications is October 31st 2017. The local high schools will have open evenings to help you choose the right school for your child and details of these are available on their websites.

We are holding an open morning at 10am on Friday 29th September and an open afternoon at 1.30pm on Monday 2nd October for parents with children due to start school in September 2018 and we would welcome your help in publicising this to friends and family who might be interested. The closing date for primary school admissions is January 15th 2018.

Data Collection Sheets

Data collection sheets will be coming home with your child this week. Please ensure that you check this information carefully and return to school as soon as possible. It is important that our records are kept up to date and information is updated where necessary, particularly where contact numbers may have changed.
