Twitter

We have recently created a school Twitter account. Many schools already have a Twitter account and have found them to be useful in terms of communicating with families. The benefits of Twitter to you are that you will have instant access to pictures and videos that the children and staff have created and shared. School will tweet items regularly to bring you closer to your child's learning. This is something that as a school, we are very excited about and we hope you share our enthusiasm.

To find us on twitter, search for **@CapenhurstCEPS**; you will be able to view our tweets without creating an account. However, if you want to interact with our tweets, you will need your own account. You need to log on to www.twitter.com and sign up for free. You will need to create a user name, password and input your email details. It only takes a matter of minutes. With regards to safeguarding your child, only children whose parents have consented for images and videos to be tweeted will be used in our tweets. If you have not yet completed a twitter consent form, I would be grateful if you could pop into the office and do so as soon as possible.
