Parents' Evening Reminders

Details of your allocated time slot were sent home before the half term break; please check ParentMail for confirmation

Please see below a few reminders about the routines in place for parents' evening appointments this week. There are some additional points that you are encouraged to read through.

- Only parent per appointment and no children to keep additional number of people in the building as low as possible.
- Each parent is to enter their child's class using the classroom's external door.
- Strict 10 minute appointments with a warning alarm at 8 minutes to allow time for final comments and changeover to the next appointment. Please note, if you are late for your appointment, it will be a reduced slot to enable it to finish at the original time so that the following appointment can start on time.
- Books will be made available and handed to you by the class teachers at the changeover time between appointments.
- If it is wet, C1&2 parents are asked to wait under the canopy, C3 can wait in the outdoor classroom and C4 can wait under a gazebo outside the back door.
- Parents are asked to exit the classroom and walk round to the external door if they need to move to another classroom for their next appointment. Parents will not be permitted to move to the next room within the school building.
- There will be a desktop screen between staff and parents as an additional control measure so that face-to-face conversations can take place without the need for masks. It is personal choice as to whether you wear a mask at other times, e.g. on arrival, departure, waiting outside or during the meeting.
- If either parent within the family has any Covid-19 symptoms, then no parent should attend the appointment. They should book a PCR test and in this instance, arrangements will be made to reschedule the appointment.

It is hoped that these arrangements will enable us to meet with you face-to-face to discuss how your child has settled into their class. We ask that all parents understand and respect the arrangements that have been in place – they are there to manage the health and safety of families and staff. Thank you.
