I am pleased to share with you that the governing body of Capenhurst CE Primary has a new chair and vice chair. The chair of the governing body is Mr Bob Durrell who is the grandparent of two previous pupils and was co-opted onto the governing body in September 2013. He brings with him an array of business skills that will be of great benefit to the governing body. Ms Lezley Sutherland, who became a parent governor in November 2014, has been elected as vice chair. Lezley has a range of business skills and wider interests that will be of benefit to the governing body and complement those skills already demonstrated by existing governors. We also welcome two other co-opted governors, Mr Mark Entwistle who is an Assistant Head Teacher at The Whitby High School and Mrs Michelle Hardwick a Learning and Development Trainer with a law firm in Liverpool, who is also a parent of a pupil at school.

After 3 years as a parent governor, Mrs Jayne Tunstall has resigned her post leaving a vacancy for a new parent governor. It has been pleasure to have benefitted from Mrs Tunstall's strengths and experiences during her term of office and the governing body would like to express their thanks for her hard work and commitment.
