Each week we will hear the voice of a different character from the Christmas story and see how they can inspire us to reach out to others this advent. This week we have been listening to the voice of the innkeeper who showed kindness to Mary and Joseph, taking them in when they had nowhere else to stay. Homelessness is a rising problem in the UK with an estimated 60,000 families or house-

holds affected. We can reach out to the homeless by starting our 'Giving Advent' (more info over the page).

Lord, bring hope and comfort to people who don't have a home this advent. Give us courage to help others in practical ways. Amen.


Christmas Shoeboxes
