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Attendance update

Attendance at school is vital if children are to make the most of the exciting teaching and learning opportunities that staff plan and deliver every day. Current attendance figures are 95.8% which is in line with national expectations. At school we understand that children can be unwell and there are times when staying at home is vital to their recovery. As a school we are judged on our attendance and the actions we take to encourage good attendance at school. At Capenhurst we do this through dialogue with home when children are unwell and through rewarding classes with the best attendance each week. When children are absent from school they miss out on steps in their learning that can be difficult to make up; prolonged absence may mean that larger chunks of learning are missed. We aim to work with all our families to encourage and develop good attendance habits in all our pupils so that they realise the importance of being in school and get into good habits for later life.

Learning Together sessions
