Don't forget to vote in the parent governor election, the closing date is tomorrow for all votes.



If you have a child who will be starting in **Reception** in September 2016, again you must apply for a school place through Cheshire West & Chester Council by **15th January 2016**. We will be holding an open afternoon for new reception children and their parents on Wednesday 14th October at 1.15pm.
