Traversing Wall

I am pleased to share that the traversing wall be installed during the October half term holiday. Once all the pupils are back in school, they will be given the opportunity to 'have a go' following an induction about how to use the wall safely. There will then be a rota for its use during the school day. In line with health and safety guidance due to the height of the lowest foot holds, there is no need to change the surface near the wall. Children will be instructed in its safe use before being allowed to use it. Any child who chooses to use the wall (or tyre park) in an unsafe manner will be removed from the equipment immediately and their use of it restricted until they are able to use it safely.

As with the tyre park, children are not to use the traversing wall before school. Once you have collected your child at the end of the school day you are welcome to supervise them on either the tyre park or traversing wall. There will not be any staff supervising the use of the tyre park or traversing wall before or after school. Your understanding and cooperation with this is much appreciated.
