Thank you to everyone who read through the numerous letters and emails as this made our start to the new year relatively smooth. There were a few teething problems with drop-off and pick-up but I'm confident these will ease as we all get used to them. Snacks, drinks and lunchboxes need to be named to avoid any confusion.

Each class has allotted times to visit the toilet to avoid children from different classes mixing in the toilets. This routine is taking some time to embed as the children have been used to being able to visit the toilet whenever they've needed to during their extended time at home. The visits are very regular and so far, most children are managing well. If any child shows signs of distress or has a water infection, then staff will respond accordingly in enabling that child to visit the toilet safely.

School lunches

The children have adapted well to the new routine of lunches in the classrooms. If you send a packed lunch from home with food that requires cutlery - yoghurt, salad etc. - please remember to send the cutlery from home. Cutlery is not available in school for children to use with their home packed lunch.

School lunches are available to order in the mornings at a cost of £2.40 for children in Classes 3 and 4. This is to be paid using the ParentMail system. Children in Classes 1 and 2 are eligible for a daily universal free school meal if required. Details of our current reduced menu were sent home last week.

If your circumstances have changed and you think you might be eligible to apply for a free school meal for your child/ren, please contact Cheshire West & Chester Council on 0300 123 7021 to apply. If your eldest child receives a free school meal and you have a younger child who has just started in our reception class, you will need to apply for that child too. Thank you.
