School lunches

The children have adapted well to the new routine of lunches in the classrooms. If you send a packed lunch from home with food that requires cutlery - yoghurt, salad etc. - please remember to send the cutlery from home. Cutlery is not available in school for children to use with their home packed lunch.

School lunches are available to order in the mornings at a cost of £2.40 for children in Classes 3 and 4. This Children in Classes 1 and 2 are eligible for a daily universal free school meal. A slice of toast or half a bagel can be ordered daily for snack at a cost of 30p per day. The register is updated on a Friday for the week's orders. Payment for lunch and snack is to be made via ParentMail.

If your circumstances have changed and you think you might be eligible to apply for a free school meal for your child/ren, please contact Cheshire West & Chester Council on 0300 123 7021 to apply. If your eldest child receives a free school meal and you have a younger child who has just started in our reception class, you will need to apply for that child too. Thank you.
