Uniform Reminder

At Capenhurst we are proud of our tradition of wearing a school uniform. Girls are expected to have long hair fastened back at all times in school. Please keep hair accessories to a minimum, restricting the use of large hair decorations to non-uniform days. Your cooperation with this is appreciated.

Water Bottles

It was noted at our recent health and safety inspection that the water pressure on our water fountain is low and despite attempts to increase the pressure, it has not been possible to do so. Therefore, we would suggest that the children bring in a named water bottle to keep in school that they can refill each day.

Mid-day Vacancies

Due to a change in circumstance for our most recently appointed mid-day, we have a vacancy for a mid-day assistant. There is a degree of flexibility over the number of days worked in this role. The role is an interesting and varied role that involves serving meals, supervising the children as they eat and encouraging them to eat their food, clearing away and cleaning the rooms ready for afternoon school and supervising the children as they play. We take safeguarding very seriously at Capenhurst and all the required disclosure and barring checks will be made as well as an expectation of confidentiality and professionalism if appointed.
