### School BBQ - Friday 30th September

This is the return of our (previously) annual start-of-year BBQ where families and staff can get together to start the year and we can all welcome new families to our school community. It is a ticketed event and an order form was attached to last week's newsletter using ParentMail. All food items must be ordered and paid for (by cash only) in advance. As well as a BBQ, there will be stalls and games organised by pupils in class 4 and members of Friends of Capenhurst. It is an informal, social occasion with some fundraising and it is held on the school playground. We aim to start about 3.30pm and it is typically finished before 5pm. We hope many of you are able to come along and join us, even if only for a short time, before heading off for the weekend.

### Harvest

Pre-school will be joining school for a Harvest Service on Thursday 6th October during the afternoon. We welcome harvest food donations in support of the Foodbank during the week of 3rd October. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate any parents/carers at the service as there is a very little space in church once school and pre-school are seated.

Therefore, we have decided to host a Harvest/MacMillan Coffee morning on Friday 7th October from 9 to 10.30am and invite our families to join us. During the session, each class will come over to share their songs, poems and prayers from the service. The coffee morning will be an opportunity to come together and share cakes, drinks and conversation as well as raising money for MacMillan Cancer.

### Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - **All in, bring a tin!**

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. This token can then be exchanged for a food item from the 'Selfless Shelves' which can then be placed in the Foodbank. Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the shelves - the children see this as a 'Circle of Kindness'. The Foodbank will then use these items to support local families struggling to provide food for themselves.

We will continue to support the West Cheshire Foodbank in our traditional way and food items can be brought in and placed on the 'Selfless Shelves' or directly into the collection box. This week, the Foodbank is particularly in need of **UHT milk, UHT juice, instant coffee (small jars), instant mash, instant pasta/noodles, tinned meats and tinned puddings.**
