#### School lunches & snacks

Outstanding lunch and snack bills were sent home with your child on Friday (if applicable). Where possible, please pay for lunches and snacks on the day or for a week/month in advance. This will greatly reduce time spent chasing payments by Mrs Auld.

From September 2018, the price of a school lunch has increased to £2.30 for children in Year 3 and above (who are not eligible for a free school meal). Children in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 are still able to receive a free school meal. Prices for snacks remain the same, (30p for toast/half a bagel; 60p for a bacon butty - Fridays only). Please send payment in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and what is enclosed. Cheques should be made payable to "CWAC". Thank you.
