The group provides fundraising updates and general school reminders.

### Welcome Back BBQ

We will be holding our annual 'start of the year' BBQ. This is an opportunity for families and friends to come along and get to know each other and catch up after the summer break. Staff will be there to spend time getting to know you and your families. A letter with details of tickets etc. will be sent home very soon.

<u>School lunches</u> We have a new three weekly rolling menu for school lunches this year. The menus were sent home by email yesterday (or were enclosed with our new children's starter packs) and are also on the school website, thev www.capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk and on the noticeboard on the side of school.

From September 2019, the price of a school lunch has increased to £2.40 for children in Year 3 and above (who are not eligible for a free school meal). Children in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 are still able to receive a free school meal. A slice of toast will remain the same at 30p but a bacon butty (Fridays only) will be 70p. Dinners and snacks should be paid online via Parent-Mail. Details of how to register for our new families will be sent home shortly.

### Swimming Lessons for Y3-Y6

Swimming lessons start on Tuesday 10th September for children in KS2 for the duration of the Autumn Term. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time as we will be leaving promptly at 9am in order to arrive in Chester on time. Your child will need to bring appropriate swim wear (one piece swimsuit), goggles if your child usually wears them, and a towel each Tuesday morning. If needed, they should bring a snack from home, as they will miss morning school break so there will be no toast available. It would be useful if they could come to school with their swim wear underneath their school uniform, but please remember to pack underwear for afterwards! Please ensure that you give consent via ParentMail and that payment is made for the coach transport on ParentMail by 10th September. Thank you.

### Premier Sports

Mr Ellis will be joining us to teach PE across school on Mondays this year. He will be awarding a PE award each week to one pupil who has excelled in some way in his lessons which will be handed out during sharing assembly each week. We are able to continue with this high quality P.E. provision through careful deployment of the Sports Premium funding which is delegated to each school to enhance P.E. provision for all children. We also spend this money on subsiding after-school clubs and other sporting activities as well as paying for swimming teaching and lifeguard provision for school swimming lessons.
