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Class 4 Farm Visit - Thursday 3rd July

Please apply insect spray (if required) and sun cream to your child before school and remember to bring a sun hat.

Invertebrates Workshop - Thursday 17th July

Mr Broomfield, Eddie's dad, has kindly offered to run some invertebrate workshops, linking to our science curriculum, for the children on Thursday 17th July. The sessions will cover what an Invertebrate is and how they are different from vertebrates; the distribution of invertebrates in terms of numbers and locations; using the world map, choosing an area and exploring what invertebrates live there. There is the possibility of handling of four species, fully risk assessed. I can confirm there will be no handling of spiders or scorpions!
